

## **Supply list for Fabric Postcard Workshop**

- **Working sewing machine with a new or sharp needle (I use 90/14 Schmetz)**
- **Scissors (fabric)**
- **Fabric scraps - you will not need any piece bigger than 5" X 7"**
- **Muslin or cream/white fabric for the postcard back, cut to 4" X 6"**
- **Fusible Web (I use Wonder Under or Steam A Seam Lite)**
- **Threads to match the backing for the bobbin & threads for the scraps on top. I usually pick a light grey.**
- **Fabric pen or marker - should be permanent (I use either a Pigma Micron or a Zig Millennium )**
- **ruler**
- **rotary cutter, ruler & cutting mat**
- **batting - any thickness, at least 5" X 7"**
- **cardboard - I use cereal boxes, cut to 4" X 6"**
- **iron & ironing pad or board**
- **parchment paper or teflon pressing sheet**
- **pins**
- **little binder clips, 2 of them.**

Optional:

fibres

embroidery floss

metallic threads

bridal tulle, white or beige

collage papers
